Brenda had always wanted to produce a Christmas album, but sadly, time ran away with her, and it never happened. This compilation of previously published tracks, together with additional archive material recently discovered on old private recordings, we hope will give you a flavour of Brenda's enjoyment of music at Christmas, one of her favourite times of the year.

There are 15 tracks - a couple of cracking Christmas carols with Mousehole Male Voice Choir and Camborne Town Band, some little-known tracks from her earlier recordings, a few much-loved old favourites, and a couple of previously unpublished tracks with Al Fenn, recorded at Pipers Folk Club on New Year's Eve, when it was based in the Gulval Meadhouse in the 1970s.

These are vintage recordings, many available for the first time on CD, and Mic McCreadie has done sterling work to bring them up to suitable quality.
